Columbia Dancin' Dolls Grading Policy

As per the Constitution, each doll must be enrolled in the Dance/PE equivalent class during the fall and spring semesters each school year. Grades will be based on class participation, bringing appropriate supplies to class, and adherence to the rules and expectations set forth by the director. Below is a breakdown of how a student's grade will be determined:

- Each day in class students will be required to bring the designated practice attire set forth by the director. Failure to bring the correct items will result in points lost on the student's weekly average.
 - Correct top= 5 points
 - Correct bottom= 5 points
 - Appropriate shoes= 5 points
 - Hair pulled back= 5 points
- Failure to participate in class activities will result in a "0" for the day. If a student is physically unable to participate in class activities, an alternate assignment will be given to them.
- Students will only be graded for the days that they are present in class.
 Failure to attend practice will be handled as a discipline issue, not as a grading issue.
